

# CONSENT MEANS...

**Consent** means free and informed agreement between the parties to participate in a sexual act. The following considerations, amongst others, should guide parties:

- Parties must be able to communicate and agree on the type of sexual activities that will be shared. Either party has the right to change her/his mind, at any time, and is responsible for communicating that change.
- It is the responsibility of the person who initiates any type of sexual activity to obtain the other person's consent.
- Consent to one type of sexual act does not necessarily imply consent to other forms of sexual activities.
- Silence does not imply consent.
- A previous or present sexual or other relationship between the parties does not imply consent.
- Consent is not implicit in a person's manner of dress.
- Accepting a social invitation is not consent, nor does it imply consent.
- Consent will not be effective when it is obtained, or perceived to be obtained, from a person whose capacity to consent is diminished (including, but not limited to, reduced capacity due to alcohol use, medicines or any other substance).
