THEME - THE STATE OF TRANSFORMATION AT NELSON MANDELA UNIVERSITY - 31 January

Nelson Mandela University started implementing its second 5-year Institutional Transformation Plan (ITP) in 2023. With the inauguration of Prof Muthwa in 2018 and the executive Engagement and Transformation Portfolio in 2020, various realignment processes have been initiated to reposition the university as a responsive, transformative university, in service of society.

The Transformation Oversight Committee commissioned research on the state of transformation in public South African Universities. It released a **report** which provided insight into the different ways Transformation is being framed and reported across the sector. The report also provides a proposed framework for operationalising transformation indicators.

The purpose of the Indaba is to:

- Provide an overview of progress made with ITP implementation in 2023 per MANCO portfolio;
- Discuss Nelson Mandela University's framing of Transformation relative to the 2023 sectoral report;
- Refine the 2024 ITP objectives; and
- Identify critical indicators linked to the ITP goals.
